## ABRF Core Administrators Network Survey: Developing a Database of Core Administrators

## Abstract

CAN-CC was established by the ABRF in 2010 to facilitate greater interaction among core scientists and administrators and with the goal of creating a set of references, procedures and best practices for institutions engaged in core facility management and oversight. In particular, we seek to develop a database of core administrators, identify and describe core management model systems, and identify, collect and describe tools for core administration. Here we summarize results from our first survey, representing responses from 172 individuals from 79 institutions, that investigates the demographics of core facility management/administration and overall factors common to most cores.
